

With more and more individuals now receiving their COVID-19 vaccines across the province, the Ministry of Labour, Training and Skills Development recently issued a guidance document to explain how vaccines work to protect you when you are vaccinated and why COVID-19 workplace control measures need to be maintained even after individuals are vaccinated.

In line with this guidance, we remind everyone entering a courthouse or MAG facility to continue to diligently follow the health and safety measures that are in place, including maintaining physical distancing, practicing hand hygiene and adhering to masking protocols.

For anyone who may not have been eligible to receive their vaccine under the “essential worker who cannot work from home” category, we are pleased to let you know that the [province recently expanded](#) their booking eligibility at mass immunization clinics to all individuals aged 18 and over.

As of Tuesday, May 18, 2021, individuals aged 18 and over across Ontario became eligible to book a COVID-19 vaccine appointment through the [provincial booking system](#) and call centre, or directly through public health units that use their own booking system.

We continue to encourage everyone to access their vaccine as soon as possible.
