CERTIFIED SPECIALIST PROGRAM – LAW SOCIETY OF ONTARIO

CHILD, YOUTH, AND FAMILY SERVICES ACT - 5 YEAR REVIEW

The five-year legislative review of the <u>Child, Youth and Family Services Act, 2017</u> (CYFSA) has been officially launched. The CYFSA is the primary legislation governing child, youth and family services that are provided through the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services. This includes services such as child welfare, adoption, youth justice and out-of-home care services, as well as services for First Nations, Inuit and Métis children and youth.

The legislation requires that a formal review and a public report be completed every five years. The CYFSA was proclaimed in 2018, and the 2023 review will be the first review of the legislation.

MINISTRY OF FINANCE: MULTI-EMPLOYER PENSION PLANS (MEPPS)

The Ministry of Finance (MOF) is seeking feedback on a proposal to establish a permanent framework for target benefit plans in regulations made under the Pensions Benefits Act. This framework will

impact how the value of pension benefits is calculated for the purposes of family law matters for all Multi-Employer Pension Plans (MEPPs) that can reduce accrued benefits. MINISTRY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

JUSTICE SERVICES ONLINE FEEDBACK SESSIONS: In late March, MAG and FOLA hosted a series of regional JSO Feedback Sessions. These sessions offered productive and respectful dialogue between the ministry, bar, and bench on online filing services and gave JSO users the opportunity to ask questions, share any challenges they may be experiencing, and suggest possible improvements to the platform, both in advance of and during the sessions. The ministry received important feedback about JSO, such as suggestions to further increase document size limitations and streamline user communication with court staff about a submission. The JSO project team is carefully reviewing all of the feedback and, in response, is exploring ways to enhance JSO and related operational processes. A summary of the feedback when available. REMINDER: ONTARIO'S NOT-FOR-PROFIT ACT: Ontario's Not-for-Profit Corporations Act (ONCA) took effect on October 19, 2021. Existing non-profits have 3 years from that date to bring their governing documents into compliance with the new law. Learn more on our <u>ONCA Resource Page</u>.

LIRN "CLAWBACKS"

As you may recall, last year LiRN advised law associations that they intended to move forward with a "clawback" of previously unused grants unless the association could create an appropriate business case to redirect those funds. Associations should be aware that LiRN has not provided - and will not provide - FOLA with any specific financial information of any individual association. LiRN has previously advised that the association's financial information is confidential and they will not disclose it to us without the written consent of the individual association. As a result, they have not made us aware of their final decisions regarding the clawbacks. For this reason, we are inviting associations with concerns to follow up with either of us if you have concerns about any business case you've made or that was rejected. It has a mandate to provide excellence in administrative justice through the effective resolution of a wide range of labour relations and employment disputes. The Board mediates and adjudicates disputes under the Ontario Labour Relations Act, the Employment Standards Act, the Occupational Health and Safety Act, the School Boards Collective Bargaining Act, Public Sector Labour Relations Transition Act and numerous other labour and employment statutes. The Ontario Labour Relations Board is seeking a full-time Vice-Chair. Deadline is May 31st.
