ONTARIO'S STANDING COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE POLICY

Ontario's Standing Committee on Justice Policy is conducting a study on the reform of Canada's bail system as it relates to the provincial administration of justice and public safety with regard to persons accused of violent offences or offences associated with firearms or other weapons. The Committee intends to hold public hearings on **Monday, January 30, 2023 and Tuesday, January 31, 2023**.

REMINDER: DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING BUSINESS CASES FOR EXCESS FUNDS:

LiRN has once again extended the deadline for fund balance proposals. The new deadline for submitting your business case is **TODAY** (Jan 25, 2023).

Association's business cases will be presented to LiRN's Audit and Finance Committee and Board meetings, currently scheduled in February. Associations will be notified of the results of the Board meeting as soon as practicable thereafter.

As a reminder, the business cases should include:

- The initiative
- The cost of the initiative
- The amount of the excess fund balance required
- How the initiative aligns with LiRN's mandate and supports and improves the library network
- How the initiative relates to library expenses that the LiRN grant covers, including:
 - o Library staff salaries
 - o Collection expenses
 - o Expenses related to the operation of the library
 - o Some capital expenses related to the library. Examples include library furniture, bookshelves, computers, printers, and copiers. Note that some equipment such as photocopiers may be more cost effectively procured centrally and identifying the equipment need is a necessary first step.

Please note that, as previously communicated, the Q1 grants are unaffected by the fund balance recovery process. Please contact Theresa Leitch is you have any questions: <u>TLeitch@lirn.ca</u>
